Process:

- Identify violation
- 10-day re-inspection (if mailed)
- 48-hour re-inspection (on site notice)
- Repeat offenders may receive immediate citation upon violation

Sec. 683 TX Transportation Code



- Identify Violation
- Red Tag (72 hours)
- Towing process not less than 10 days from mailed notification
